CONSTRUCTION AND MINISTRY MILESTONES

The photos on the previous page are worth a thousand words! But they don't tell the story of what's happening on the inside! Following are some important milestones that you can celebrate with us!

Nov. 2012 - Panama A/G Presbytery unanimously approves the designation of the Rana de Oro property for the LARTC.

Fall 2015 - Creek is bridged, road extended and land cleared and leveled... ready for construction.

Feb. 2016 - Lincolnton, GA MAPS team launches construction.

Feb. 20, 2017 - Move-in day!

March 9, 2017 - Dedication of Phase 1 Training/Administration Building during International Educational Leaders Dialogue.

July 29, 2017 - Final preparations complete for the month-long ISUM Seminar.

Sept. 1, 2017 - Little Davey is the first Team to stay at the Center.

Winter 2018 - Atrium roofed; Bakersfield begins construction. LARTC is looking like one building!

Oct. 5, 2018 - LARTC receives miracle offering to complete the second floor of the Phase 2 Housing building

Feb. 2019 - 13 additional guestrooms completed

April 2019 - Phase 4 roof installed/ Eastridge (Issaquah, WA) blocks walls

July 2019 - Atrium mezzanine/stairs completed, windows/doors installed

July 2019 - Commerical kitchen equipment purchased and cabinets built

OVERALL PROGRESS... 75 PERCENT!

The LARTC is now 75% complete after just three and a half years of building. Following are the construction phases with timetable, represented visually, beginning at the bottom with "0" and ending with "5" at the top. Phase "6" is finish work to be completed during the second half of construction.



- Phase 1 Addition Training/ Admin/ Production (2019-20)
- Atrium Lobby/ Auditorium/ Dining (2019-20)
- 2. Housing/ Kitchen (2017-19)
- 1. Training/ Administration/ Production (2016-17)
- O. Road/ Culvert/ Site Prep/ Utilities (2014-15)

The chart to the right shows the percentage completed for each phase, the square feet of building for phases 1-5 and the construction budget and adjusted costs for each phase.

We are humbled to think that so many churches, individuals and ministries have now invested \$1.55 million in the LARTC! Looking back strengthens our faith to look forward.

PRIORITY PROJECTS FOR 2019

In October, First Assembly Church (St. Charles, MO) will be with us to lay the second story perimeter wall block for the Phase 4 Training/Admin addition. In preparation, our goals are to completed the following by the end of 2019:

1. Phase 4 Training/Administration Addition:

-Finish Second story flooring structure and concrete.

2. Phase 3 Atrium:

- -Complete sheetrock work and paint above back windows
- -Finish laying floor tile
- -Encase and paint mezzanine and stair structure with sheetrock
- -Purchase and install glass/stainless bannisters for mezzanine and stairs
- -Purchase and install four sets of glass double doors in the hallways to each building wing
- -Purchase and install wall tiles and counters for breakfast room
- -Complete electrical work.

3. Commercial Kitchen:

- -Stainless counters for L-shaped wall cabinets and island cabinets.
- -Carts for second island
- -Purchase and install stainless steel sheeting as back splash for wash wall and cabinets.

4. Outside Work:

- -Build and finish the balcony used for the A/C compressors
- -Recess air conditioning tubing on the training/administration building and finish painting
- -Extend perimeter security wall.
